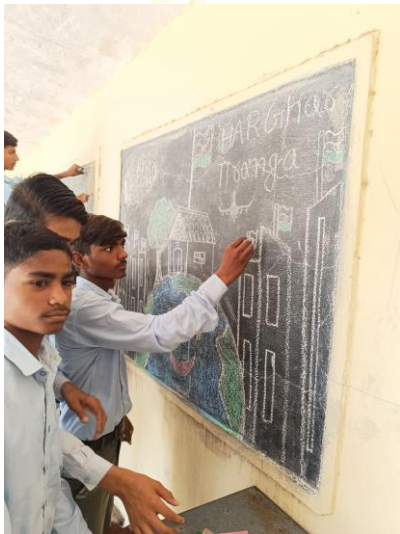
Tiranga canvas Signature
